ICTSI secures new 30 years Lease

Background/Description of the Disclosure

International Container Terminal Services, Inc. (ICTSI) which operates the multipurpose terminal at the Port of Gdynia in Poland, had earlier signed a new 30-year lease for the Baltic Container Terminal (BCT) with the Port Authority of Gdynia S.A. (PAGSA). This new lease extends the operations of BCT, which started in 2003, until 2053.

BCT represents an important component in Poland's port infrastructure – it functions as a key maritime gateway for containers and general cargo, connecting the entire Polish hinterland and beyond through efficient rail and road corridors.

ICTSI is delighted to extend its cooperation with the Port of Gdynia for another 30 years.
